US UC Patient Research Method & Report Notes

Method Statement

The Finland Ulcerative Colitis (UC) patient survey was conducted online by The Harris Poll on behalf of Pfizer between November 4 and December 13, 2021, among 184 adults age 18+ who:

- Reside in Finland
- ✓ have been diagnosed with ulcerative colitis.
- have seen someone at a gastroenterologist or internist's office in the past 3 years
- have had a colonoscopy or flexible
 sigmoidoscopy to confirm their diagnosis

- have not had a colectomy
- have ever taken any prescription medication for their UC other than only a 5-ASA
- provided informed consent to complete the research


Respondents were recruited via public links distributed by Crohn's and Colitis Finland on their website and on their social media platforms. Raw data were not weighted at the individual country level and are therefore only representative of the individuals who completed the survey.

More than two in three UC patients in Finland report excellent or good overall health






While the majority of patients say their UC is in remission, two in five say it has been in remission less than a year


UC In Remission



Two in five patients in Finland feel that their UC controls their life


I feel that my UC controls my life, rather than me controlling the disease.

Changes in Amount of Flares since 2019






Disease Management & Treatment

Non-Prescription Treatments <u>Currently</u> Doing








For three in five UC patients in Finland, the pandemic has negatively impacted their emotional wellbeing

COVID-19 Pandemic Impact on...






Close to three in five UC patients in Finland have never used and never plan to use symptom tracking or disease management apps






More than half of patients say they discussed UC life impacts and goal setting to manage their disease with their doctor during the pandemic

■ Did before pandemic ■ Did during pandemic ■ Plan to do after pandemic ■ Have never done or plan to do






While many say they were hesitant to make changes to their UC treatment plan during the pandemic, two in five discussed and made changes



More than one in five say the pandemic negatively impacted how safe they feel taking their prescription medication for UC









Around one in three cite less busy schedules, remote work and fewer social outings as factors that made controlling UC symptoms easier in the pandemic

Factors that Made Controlling Symptoms Easier During the Covid-19 Pandemic






More than one in three patients in Finland note improvement in symptom tracking during the pandemic






More than a third say having more anxiety/stress made controlling UC symptoms harder during the pandemic

One in five felt more isolated in managing their UC during the COVID-19 pandemic and are worried about controlling symptoms post-pandemic






Healthcare Access, Experiences, & Preferences



Satisfaction with Ability to Access Needed **Health Care During Covid-19 Pandemic**


Number of Doctor's Appointments for UC Since Start of Covid-19 Pandemic

UC patients in Finland are moderately more satisfied with several features of in-person appointments than virtual ones




